OPPORTUNITY

Our Academic Extension program accelerates and enriches the learning experience of students through a focus on analytical, creative, collaborative, and critical thinking skills, whilst offering opportunities to engage in a variety of extra-curricular learning experiences, to ensure students reach their full academic potential.

CHALLENGE

The program brings together like minded, highly academically capable students, fostering the development of their talents as well as caring for their social and emotional needs. Students are challenged by an accelerated and differentiated curriculum that values higher order, critical thinking and critical literacy in a student-centred learning environment. Students follow the WA Curriculum. A focus of the program is on extension and extra-curricular activities.

GROWTH

Our uniquely flexible program is available to students in Year 7 (continuing then into 8, 9 and 10) and operates in two pathways - a Maths and Science pathway and an English and Humanities & Social Sciences pathway. Students may access one or both pathways depending on their academic talents.

PROGRAM AIMS:

- Academic Extension provides the opportunity for extracurricular and crosscultural activities.
- Acceleration, extension and challenge of curriculum content (without additional workload).
- Focus on metacognition learning how to learn; not just focusing on the grade and instil an appreciation of learning for life.
- Differentiated curriculum, catering for individual needs.
- Collaborative learning, fostering teamwork.
- Student centred to develop independent thinking and learning.
- · Foster risk taking (often students are risk averse).
- Program goal for students to aspire to be the best version of themselves.





SELECTION

Selection into the Ocean Reef Academic
Extension Program is based on the results
of a selection test which is conducted at
Ocean Reef Senior High School. The
Higher Ability Selection Test (HAST) is
used by secondary schools to identify
academically gifted students for
participation in accelerated learning
and enhancement programs. HAST is
designed to measure innate ability and
academic potential unlike curriculum-based
tests which typically identify what a student has
already learned. Students will be tested in Reading.

Continued involvement in the program is reliant upon achievement in line with course expectations and maintaining Good Standing.
