APPLICATION AND SELECTION

The program is ideally suited to students who have a passion for the marine environment and would like to pursue a professional marine studies pathway in the future.

Application to the Marine Studies Program requires submission of the following by the close of applications:

- Marine Studies application form
- Proof of swimming achievement - Swim and Survive Level 7 (or equivalent qualification)
- Latest school report

Acceptance into the four year program is based on the results of the selection test, school report and meeting the swimming requirement. Students will also need to demonstrate their swimming competencies at the start of the program. Continued involvement in the Program is dependant on academic achievement and maintaining Good Standing. Students accepted into the program are required to commit to the program for four years with the option to continue in Years 11 and 12.
